My Own Color Wheel

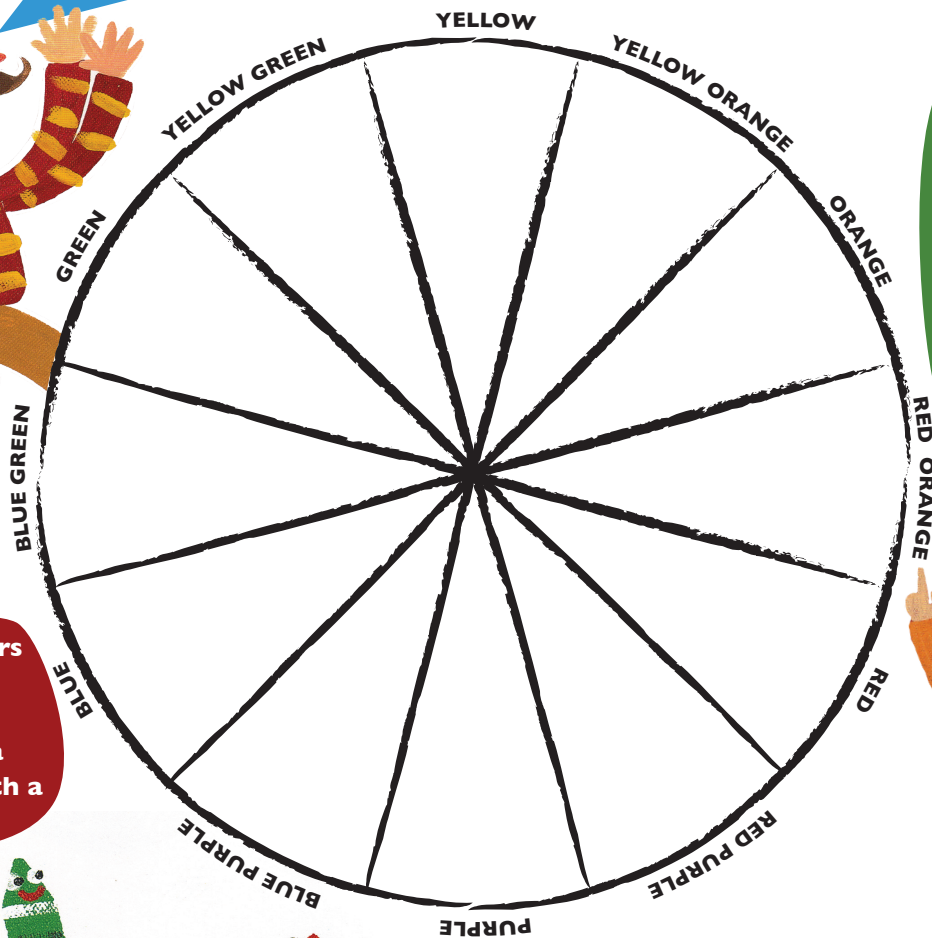
Mr. Coleur's Lesson on Color from **COLOR CHAOS!** by Lynn Rowe Reed

Making a color wheel is simple. Color the primary colors first: yellow, red, and blue. A primary color is a color from which all other colors are made.

Then add the secondary colors: orange, purple, and green. A secondary color is a color you make by mixing two primary colors.

The tertiary colors come next. A tertiary color is made by mixing a primary color with a secondary color.

Some tertiary colors are yellow orange, red purple, and blue green.
